The agencies on the list are the only agencies that are authorised to advertise eVisa facilities. Third party agencies that are not authorised are not approved to advertise the eVisa facilities. As you know any authorised agencies participating in activities such as using third parties to receive applications are monitored, checked and if required sanctioned regularly through our audit program.
